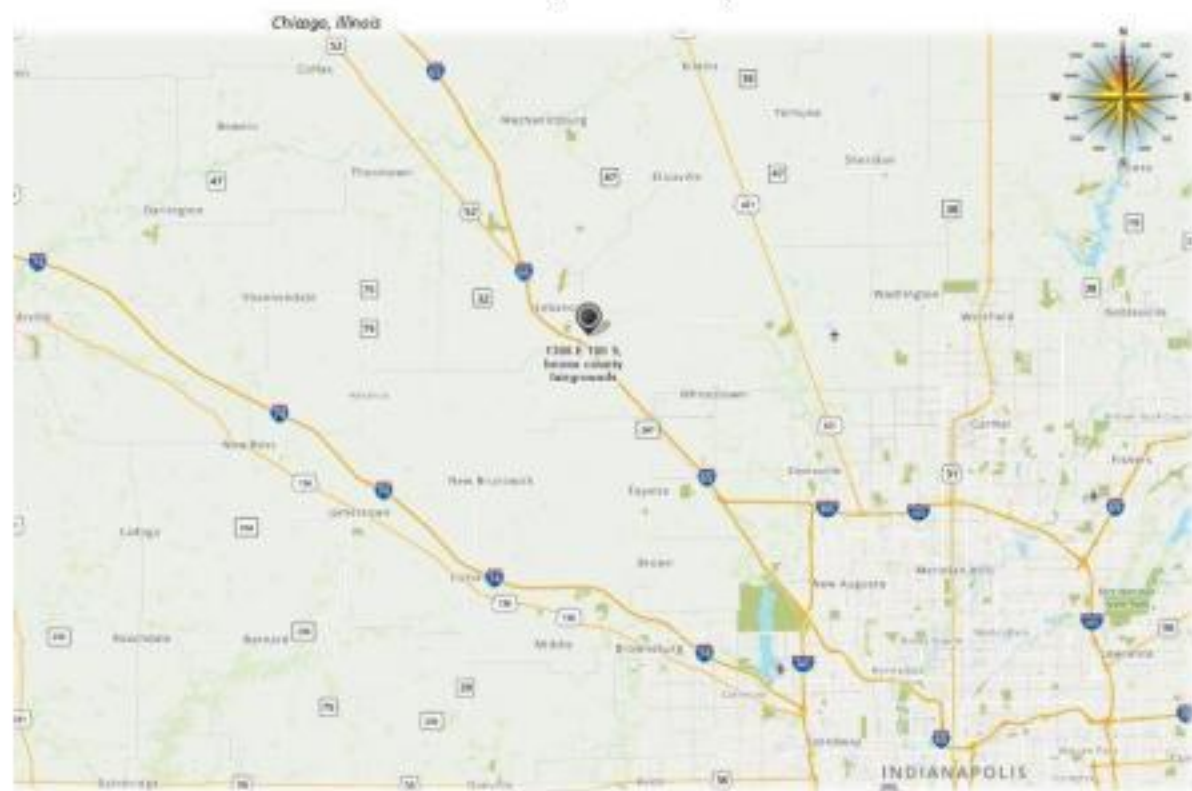
- IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 11, SEC. 11, AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS: "Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of un-entered dogs." The show-giving clubs will strictly enforce the above-stated rule. Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended
- GROOMING dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced.
- ANY CASH PRIZES will be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary is advised at once. The Secretary and Show-giving clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED the day of the show. Any unclaimed trophies will revert to the BCI general trophy fund after the showing of the breed.
- No dogs or food bowls in restrooms. Persons found violating this rule are subject to action by the Event Committee.
- Handicapped facilities are available.
- Please obey all posted signs. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HELP** to maintain this site by assisting in keeping it in excellent condition.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS ARE CHARGED** with the responsibility of cleaning in and around their rooms, vehicles, crates and dogs. Please clean after your dog(s) immediately. Please dispose of all garbage in proper containers.

**ATTENTION:** Incoming calls on cellular telephones are not allowed ringside as it interrupts judging and distracts the dogs and exhibitors.

The BCI reserves the right to substitute a prize. All trophies/prizes must be claimed the day of the show.

#### **Bred By Exhibitor class eligibility**

All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog, and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

### SWEEPSTAKES

The sweepstakes will begin at 9:00 a.m. Saturday, March 12, 2022 and is open to any registered AKC Bulldog, at least six (6) months and under 18 months of age on the date of the show. No Champions are eligible, however, dogs holding major wins may compete.

**All entries in Sweepstakes MUST be entered in Saturday's regular class.**

Entries must be made at the same time as entries for the regular class on the same form with the word Sweepstakes marked in the Additional Class box. The Sweepstakes entry fee due is \$20.00.

## PRIZES AND TROPHIES

This is a condensed form of the Premium List, as provided for in Chapter 6, Section 2A of The American Kennel Club "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows." ## SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

The Club will retain 50% of the Sweepstakes money for expenses and the other 50% will comprise the prize money. In each age and sex division the prize money will be divided as follows: First Prize - 40%, Second Prize - 30%, Third Prize - 20%, Fourth Prize - 10%

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/ Mixed Breed" Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## IMPORTANT - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - READ CAREFULLY

**ENTRY FEES** (includes \$0.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee): \$30 for first entry of each dog, \$30 for 2nd entry of same dog on same day, except Sweepstakes entries which are \$20.00, Sweepstakes entries must be entered in a regular class.

- A RECORDING FEE of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee will be collected by the Clubs and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (Chapter 11, Sec. 2, AKC Rules).
- CLOSING DATE is Wednesday, FEBRUARY 20, 2019 at 12:00PM [EST], after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.
- TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, FACSIMILE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES FROM EXHIBITORS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

- ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, or whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, no refund will be made if entry has been processed.
- RETURNED CHECKS & POST-DATED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The SHOW SECRETARY will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Sub-sequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a cash basis.

- NOTE: "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the onsite Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the start of the regular conformation judging at the show (Chapter 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules).

- THE SHOW SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE TO EXHIBITORS at discretion of the Show Committee, Saturday & Sunday, until 1 hour after all Judging ends.
- SHOW HOURS: As shown on the Judging Program. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it at ring-side when its classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.
